Pam's Promise staff is there walking side by side helping each client learn whatever skills she needs to get back on her feet and start a new life.

During this past quarter Pam's Promise has also had the joy of acquiring a new heating and cooling system at its Spring Ledge house. This new system that included replacing an old boiler with a new gas furnace, putting in a new air conditioning unit, installing an air handler and heat pump, and reworking the ductwork was done by Meyer's Heating and Cooling thanks to a grant from the Montgomery County Community Foundation. We are so grateful to be able to get this work accomplished as it will help us to assist more women and children to begin anew.

Over this quarter Pam's Promise has had the pleasure of being able to be a part of the County Drug Free Coalition which is working hard to address drug issues in Montgomery County. We are grateful for the opportunity to meet with others in our community who desire to develop ideas that will help those with drug addictions to find healing to begin anew.

A Client's Story – A New Beginning

I moved into Pam's Promise upon my release from prison at the request of my parole officer. Unsure of where I was going to live, Pam's Promise reached out to me and gave me a place to call home. The house was supplied with everyday essentials and mostly anything else I needed. It is very spacious and clean; I had a private room that locked so I felt safe and secure leaving my belongings when I went to work. My case manager was very attentive to anything I needed from a bar of soap to a shoulder to cry on. I had enough freedom to come and go as I pleased but enough structure and guidance to help me stay alcohol and drug free. Pam's Promise was the best fit for me.
